EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-04

WHEREAS, due to the threat of tropical storm Laura with potential for hurricane status development, it has been determined that immediate extreme emergency action is required to minimize the potential risks of the health and the lives of the people of Calcasieu Parish. The State of Louisiana has issued a proclamation number 112 JBE 2020 on August 28, 2020.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act, La. R.S. 29:721, et seq., confers upon the Governor of the State of Louisiana emergency powers to deal with emergencies and disasters, including those caused by fire, flood, earthquake or other natural or manmade causes, in order to ensure the preparations of this State will be adequate to deal with such emergencies or disasters and to preserve the lives and property of the people of Calcasieu Parish.

WHEREAS, all Calcasieu parish in need of emergency action, support and funding to respond to all public health and wellbeing of all human life. Said EXECUTIVE ORDER has declared a State of Extreme Emergency to exist in the Parish of Calcasieu and Sheriff Tony Mancuso, has activated all Emergency Preparedness Plans.

WHEREAS, the Calcasieu Parish Office, has implemented overtime, material purchases, professional services, construction repairs, remediation services and all other unforeseeable expenses to compact the extreme emergency due to Catastrophic Damages Hurricane Laura has inflicted on the entire Parish of Calcasieu.

NOW, THEREFORE I, Tony Mancuso, Sheriff of Calcasieu Parish, do hereby proclaim and implement the above stated orders beginning August 27, 2020.

This Proclamation issued on the 27th day of August 2020, and effective on August 27, 2020 until further notice is given.
